


## **Describing trends**

Using verb tenses


## **Action in progress**

- in the present: « The temperature is rising sharply at the moment. »
- in the past: « The temperature was rising slowly last century. »



## Looking back

- from the present to the past: « The ice cap has melted by 5% this year. »
- from earlier in the past to another point in the past: « *The northern ice cap had melted significantly between 1500 AD and 1650 AD but around 1650 the climate changed »*
- in the past and finished: « The overall temperature dropped sharply around 1650 »



## Looking back at action in progress

- action in progress up to a point in the past: « *Deforestation had been increasing rapidly but then new international laws were introduced »* 

- action in progress up to the present: « Sales of tropical wood have been decreasing in all the European markets. »
